To Whom It May Concern,

We received a notification letter in the mail from Mustang SUD informing us of a "sale" to transfer the entire water and wastewater systems and cancel the CCNs of Providence Village Water Control and Improvement District (see attached Notice).

We request to file a protest to this transaction and we request a public hearing on this matter as we believe our household and the public interest would be adversely affected by the proposed transaction for the following reasons;

- 1. PVWCID residents are obligated to continue bond payments related to the water and wastewater systems located within the Town of Providence Village. It is unfair and unjust that ownership of these facilities and CCNs should transfer to Mustang SUD without reasonable compensation. We propose an adjustment to the Application Item 1 "Sale" be checked and Application Item 11E changed to the statement "Mustang SUD will assume all remaining bond debt related to the water and wastewater systems from the effective transfer date of October 1, 2011".
- 2. This transaction, as written, does not serve the public interest. Contrary to the verified statement in Item 11E of the Application submitted by Mustang SUD to the TCEQ, water rates for the average PVWCID customer will NOT decrease. Mustang SUD's own Comparison of Water and Wastewater Rates (copy attached), a comparison review of the respective parties' rates and service fees published in the Rate Orders, and the statement "This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: Current customers will on average decrease in water rates 0%" listed on the

Notices customers received from Mustang SUD proves Mustang SUD's misrepresentation of their own facts to the TCEQ and the affected customers. We propose an adjustment to the Application Item 14 to reflect 'All the customers will be charged the same rates as they were charged before the transaction' and would add 'for the term of one year from the effective transfer date'.

3. Water service and usage rates for public lands within PVWCID will increase. The PVWCID does not charge itself a water service or usage rate but Mustang SUD will charge \$3.85 per 1,000 gallons on 16 WCID meters for a term of one year after the October 1, 2011 transfer date (Mustang SUD Feb. 2011 meeting minutes attached), effectively causing an additional rate increase to all Providence Village residential customers who fund the PVWCID through a 1.0% of assessed value ad valorem tax. As these additional rates consequentially affect residential customers, we propose an adjustment to the Application Item 14 to include a statement regarding how this rate negatively impacts the PVWCID-owned meters, any Homeowners Association meters, and the two publicly funded elementary schools located within PVWCID.

The sale is scheduled to take place as approved by the Executive Director (V.T.C.A., Water Code §13.301). The transaction and transfer and cancellation of the CCNs include the following subdivision and zip code: The Providence Village, Texas located in the 76227 zip code.

The area subject to this transaction is located approximately 8 miles east of downtown Denton, Texas and is **generally** bounded on the north by Gail Lane; on the east by Elm Fork of the Trinity River; on the south by US 380; and on the west by FM 2931 and Sanders Road.

The total area being requested includes approximately 422 acres and serves 1,722 current customers. This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: Current customers will on average decrease in water rates of 0%. Water and wastewater services will remain the same.

Affected persons may file written protests and/or request a public hearing within 30 days of this notice.

To request a hearing, you must:

- (1) state your name, mailing address and daytime telephone number;
- (2) state the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable
