On April 22, 2011, the Town of Providence Village, on behalf of itself and its citizens, asked that the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality hold an evidentiary hearing on the issue of the proposed transfer of assets from the Providence Water Control and Improvement District (Providence WCID) to Mustang Special Utility District. Those assets serve the Town and its citizens. On August 24, 2011, Ms. Tammy Benter, as representative of the Executive Director, notified the Town that a hearing would not be requested, and that instead the TCEQ would approve the application to transfer.

I am a citizen of the Town of Providence Village, receive water and sewer service from Providence WCID, and will be adversely affected by the proposed transfer. I am intervening to support the Town's Motion to Overturn, filed on August 20, 2011. I urge the Commission to reverse the Executive Director's decision to grant the transfer administratively, and to instead hold a hearing on whether the public interest will be served by the transfer.
