**ORDER NO. 3
REQUIRING SECOND STATUS REPORT AND
CONSOLIDATING PROCEEDINGS**

I. Applications

In September 2013, BCWK, L.P. and BC Humble Enterprises LLC filed applications for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificates of convenience and necessity in Harris County. On September 1, 2014, these applications were transferred to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and assigned the above referenced docket numbers.

II. Requiring Second Status Report

On October 28, 2014, Commission Staff responded to Order No. 2 requesting an opportunity to provide further updates regarding the status of this proceeding. Commission Staff and a representative for the purchaser are in contact and have agreed to file a further status report regarding the development of any necessary maps, certificates, and tariffs in order to permit the final processing of this proceeding by November 28, 2014.

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Consistent with Commission Staff's representation, Commission Staff and the parties shall file, not later than **November 28, 2014**, a further status report or a recommendation and proposed notice of approval, as necessary, for processing this proceeding

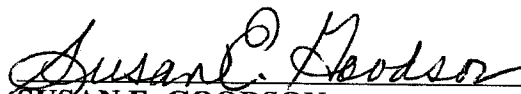
II. Motion to Consolidate

Commission Staff also requested consolidation of Docket Nos. 42949 and 42950 pursuant to P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.34 which provides that proceedings may be consolidated if the proceedings involve common questions of law or fact, that consolidation would serve the interest of efficiency, and that the applicant and other parties are not unduly prejudiced. Commission Staff stated that the proceedings involve the same transaction, and because they were processed as a single proceeding by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality before being transferred to the Commission, these proceedings meet the criteria in P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.34.

Consistent with Commission Staff's request, Docket Nos. 42949 and 42950 are consolidated into Docket No. 42949 and styled as follows: *Applications of BCWK, L.P. and BC Humble Enterprises for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificates of Convenience and Necessity in Harris County* (37719-S and 37720-S). **Parties shall file all subsequent pleadings in Docket No. 42949 only.**
