THIRD NOTICE FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT

On June 26, 2015, Commission Staff commented that the application of Aqua Utilities, Inc. and Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua Texas) regarding a sale, transfer or merger in Chambers, Jefferson and Liberty Counties, is still deficient and not administratively complete as specifically described in Commission Staff's June 26, 2015 filing. Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.8(a), applications are not considered filed until a determination of administrative completeness is made, thus at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.


Applicant should not send out notice to affected parties until these discrepancies are corrected.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Aqua Texas' application remains administratively incomplete and deficient. On or before **July 3, 2015**, Applicant shall amend its application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

On or before **July 17, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule.
