AQUA TEXAS' SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 11

TO THE HONORABLE ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE:

COME NOW, Aqua Utilities, Inc. and Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas ("Aqua Texas" or "Applicants") and file this Supplemental Response to Order No. 11 Fourth Notice Finding Application Incomplete and Deficient. In support thereof, Aqua Texas would show the following.

I. BACKGROUND

On June 4, 2014, Aqua Texas filed a Sale, Transfer, or Merger ("STM") application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality ("TCEQ") to transfer certain certificated water service areas and assets from Aqua Utilities, Inc. to Aqua Texas, Inc. as part of a reorganization effort. Aqua Texas used maps prepared by TCEQ with its application submission with the permission of TCEQ Staff. Since the September 1, 2014 transfer of CCN jurisdiction to the Commission, Aqua Texas has been working with Commission Staff to provide acceptable maps and service area descriptions for the Application. The latest effort was in response to Order No. 11 in which Aqua Texas was instructed to cure certain deficiencies identified by Commission Staff on July 17, 2015. On July 23, 2015, Aqua Texas filed its response to Order No. 11. However, on August 11, 2015, Aqua Texas was informed Staff identified additional deficiencies. In an effort to finally achieve a Staff recommendation for acceptance by Staff's next deadline, Aqua Texas hereby files this supplemental response with supplemental application information to cure the newly identified deficiencies.

II. SUPPLEMENTAL APPLICATION INFORMATION PROVIDED

In response to Commission Staff's last filed recommendation, Aqua Texas created revised maps which were attached to its Response to Order No. 11. Those maps have been further revised

to conform to directions received during an August 11, 2015 teleconference with Commission Staff in which certain additional minor map deficiencies were identified. The requested revisions include labeling each tract on certain maps with CCN numbers, and adjusting one of the maps to have all certificated areas for Aqua Texas' Gray Utility Service Water System wholly on one map. Maps incorporating Staff's requested additional revisions are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

III. CONCLUSION

Aqua Texas respectfully requests, upon confirmation by Commission Staff, that the ALJ issue an order finding the application administratively complete and directing Commission Staff to continue application processing. If for any reason Commission Staff does not view the attachments as sufficient for application acceptance, Aqua Texas respectfully requests that it be notified immediately and provided an opportunity to cure any remaining deficiencies that are identified.



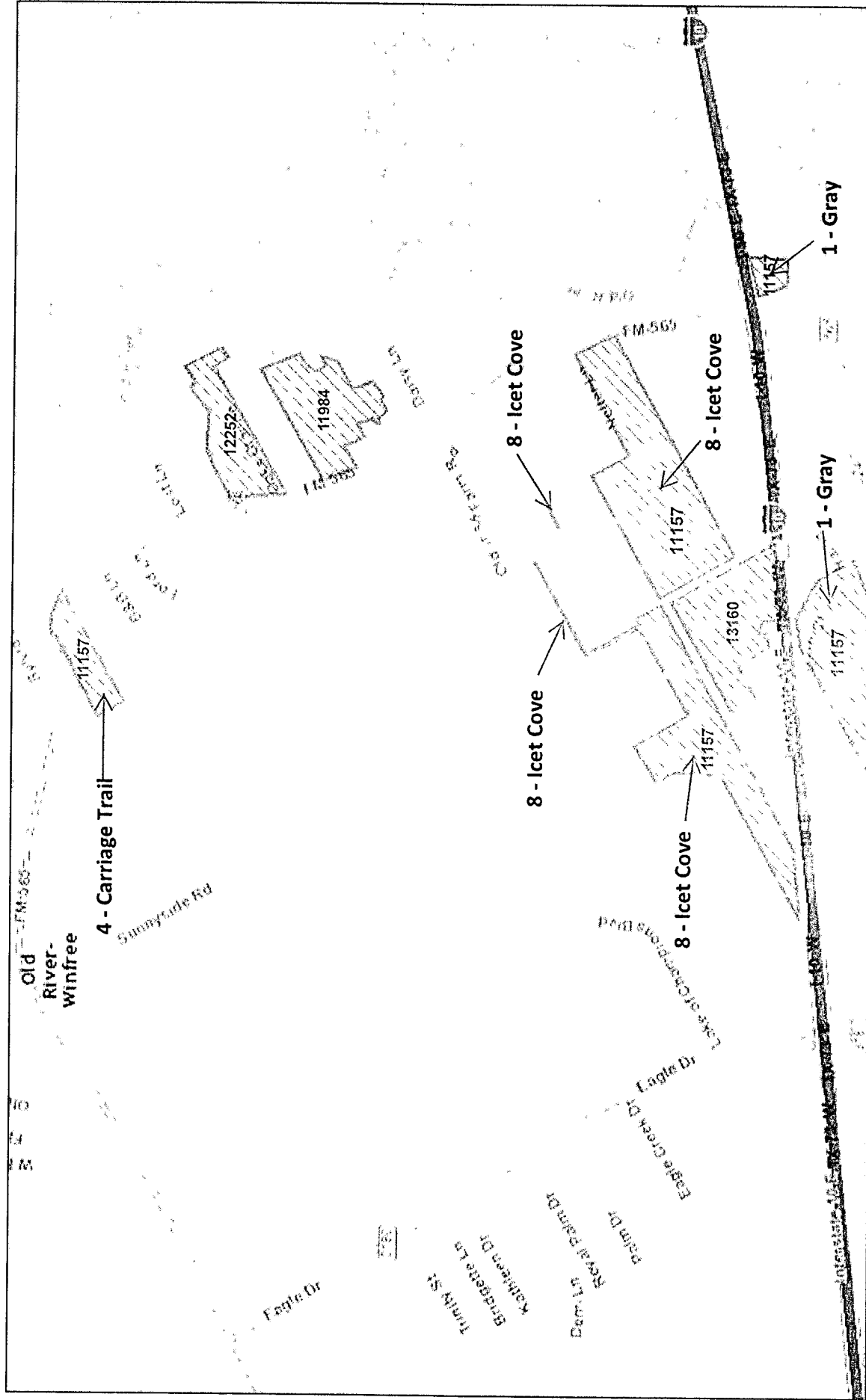

Water CCN Service Areas

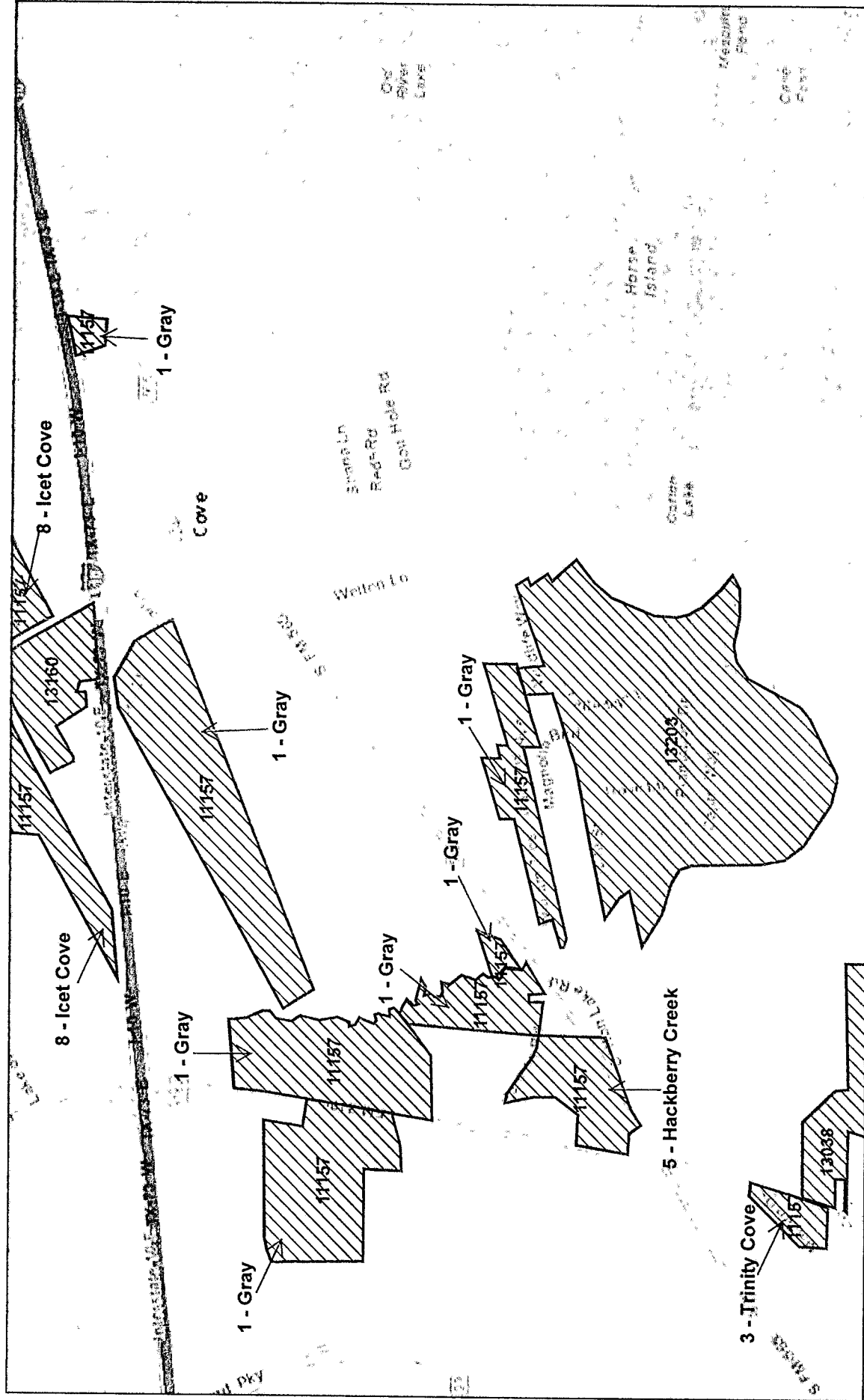

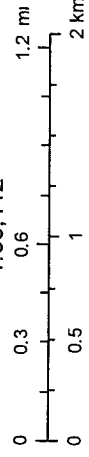
