

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- i. metes and bounds survey certified by a licensed state or register professional land surveyor; or
- ii. projectable digital data with metadata (proposed areas should be in a single record and clearly labeled). Also, a data disk labeled with the applicant's name must be provided; or
- iii. following verifiable natural and man-made landmarks; or
- iv. a copy of recorded plat map with metes and bounds.
- C. A written description of the proposed service area.
- D. Provide separate and additional maps of the proposed area(s) to show the following:
 - 1. all facilities, illustrating separately facilities for production, transmission, and distribution of the applicant's service(s); and
 - 2. any facilities, customers or area currently being served outside the applicant's certificated area(s).

No written description, acreage or number of existing customers located within the proposed service area was provided with this application. Applicant noticed public water systems, rather than those utilities and districts, which are located within the proposed CCN service areas. Applicant must notice all cities and ETJ's within 2 miles of proposed service area and any other utilities, districts, counties or entities required to receive notice.
