**ORDER NO. 10
APPROVING SALE/TRANSFER TO PROCEED**

On June 3, 2014, Aqua Utilities, Inc. and Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in McLennan County. On July 24, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff recommended that Applicants be allowed to proceed with the transaction and that Applicants promptly provide the final sale documents so that final mapping can be contemplated. Commission Staff also proposed revised procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the transaction between Applicants represented in this application may proceed and be consummated. As soon as possible after the effective date of the transaction, but not later than 30 days after the effective date of the transaction, Applicants shall file proof that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits addressed as required by 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 24.112(d) (TAC). The Applicants are advised that their CCNs will not be amended until final approval is issued in this application.


Pursuant to 16 TAC § 24.112(e), Applicants have one year to complete the transaction. If the transaction is not consummated within this period, or an extension granted, this approval is void and Applicants will have to reapply for approval of the transaction. In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, beginning **August 28, 2015**, and continuing monthly thereafter, Applicants shall file a status update regarding their efforts to conclude the transaction and submit documents evidencing consummation.

Within 10 working days of Applicants' submission of proof to the Commission that the transaction has been consummated and customer deposits addressed, Commission Staff shall file a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the documents and propose a schedule for continued processing of this docket.
