No written description, acreage or number of existing customers provided for the proposed service areas. Applicant only gave list of public water systems, instead of utilities, districts, counties, cities, etc within the proposed CCN service areas. Applicant must clearly mark or highlight proposed water CCN service areas on all hard copy maps being transferred by application.
