ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION PACKAGE ADMINISTRATIVELY
INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING DEADLINE TO CURE DEFICIENCIES


On December 19, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff determined this application to be materially deficient. Commission Staff identified multiple mapping and related notice deficiencies in the application and stated that Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua) failed to provide a general location map that accurately delineates the proposed service area within each county. Commission Staff recommended that Aqua (1) provide a general location map delineating the proposed service with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed area within each county or counties; (2) provide a map to scale which clearly labels the proposed service area in accordance with P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.105(a)(2); (3) provide separate and additional maps of the proposed area to show all facilities, illustrating separate facilities for production, transmission, and distribution of Aqua's service(s) and any facilities, customers, or area currently being served outside of Aqua's certificated area, including a map showing requests for water service within the proposed service area; and (4) provide a written description of the proposed service areas.

For the foregoing reasons, the application package is administratively incomplete. On or before **January 30, 2015**, Aqua shall amend its application in order to cure the mapping deficiencies identified by Commission, including submission of a revised proposed notice.
