ORDER NO. 11 FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE SCHEDULE

On October 12, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of the closing documentation submitted on October 2, 2015, by Aqua Utilities, Inc. and Aqua Texas, Inc. d/b/a Aqua Texas (Aqua Texas). Specifically, Commission Staff recommended that the closing documents be deemed sufficient proof that the sale has been consummated.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendations, the entirety of the closing documentation provided by Aqua Texas is sufficient to show that the transaction has been completed as agreed to by both parties and no customer deposits are at issue.

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for further processing. Accordingly, the following procedural schedule is adopted:
