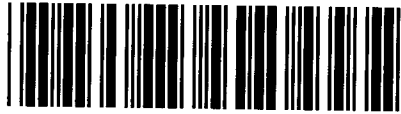

**ORDER NO. 1
REQUIRING COMMENTS ON STATUS**

I. Application

The City of Lyford filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Willacy County. The application was received by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on November 20, 2014.

II. Filings

Unless otherwise specified, an original and ten copies of documents relating to this proceeding must be filed with the Commission filing clerk according to 16 Tex. Admin. Code. 22.71 (TAC). A copy of each document filed with the Commission must also be served on all parties as provided in 16 TAC § 22.74. All filings can be accessed on the PUC Interchange, <http://interchange.puc.texas.gov>.

All parties shall provide their current addresses, telephone and facsimile numbers, if available, to all other parties and the Commission by filing and serving all parties with such information. Each party shall provide the Commission and all parties with updated address, telephone, and facsimile information if such information changes. The telephone and facsimile numbers will be placed on the service list for this proceeding. Parties are responsible for updating their own service lists to reflect changed information and the addition of any other parties.

III. Ex Parte Communications

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.3(b)(2) *ex parte* communications with the administrative law judges and presiding officer (collectively, ALJs) are prohibited. Parties shall communicate with the ALJs only through written documents filed with the Commission's Filing Clerk and served on


all parties. Questions concerning this order or any other order must be submitted in writing, filed with the Commission, and served on all parties of record.

IV. Status Update

In order to ensure the continued processing of the application, on or before **September 21, 2015**, Commission Staff shall file an update on the status of this proceeding, and if appropriate, propose a procedural schedule for processing.
