COMMISSION STAFF'S STATUS UPDATE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Status Update. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

The City of Lyford filed an application to amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Willacy County. The Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) received the application on November 20, 2014. On August 21, 2015, the Commission's Administrative Law Judge issued Order No. 1 requiring Staff to file an update on the status of this proceeding, and if appropriate, propose a procedural schedule for processing.

II. STATUS REPORT AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 20, 2005, the City of Lyford filed a letter with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) stating that the City of Lyford did not concur with TCEQ Staff's maps, certificates and recommendation because they were inconsistent with the settlement documents the City of Lyford previously filed. On November 21, 2005, North Alamo Water Supply Corp. filed a letter stating that it agreed with the City of Lyford that the map attached to TCEQ's order dated September 12, 2005, did not accurately reflect the agreement of the parties.


In order to complete the processing of this application, Staff either will file a copy of the final TCEQ order demonstrating that the application process was completed, or a final recommendation.
