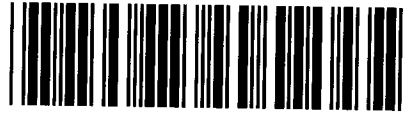

**ORDER NO. 3  
GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**


On October 26, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a response to Order No. 2, requesting additional time to file a recommendation. Commission Staff stated in order to complete the processing of the application additional information is needed from the City of Lyford (Applicant). Specifically, Commission Staff requests Applicant be required to confirm whether it intends to pursue the application. If it is the intent of Applicant to pursue the application, Commission Staff requests Applicant provide the following: (1) a large scale map showing the proposed water service area that Applicant and North Alamo Water Supply Corporation (North Alamo) agreed to in their settlement; and (2) a signed document stating both Applicant and North Alamo concur with the large scale map.

Commission Staff proposed a procedural schedule for further processing. Accordingly, the following procedural schedule is adopted:

Deadline for Applicant to provide additional information	December 10, 2015
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a final recommendation	January 7, 2016
If no disputed issues, deadline for parties to file a proposed order, including findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	January 21, 2016
