### CITY OF LYFORD'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On October 27, 2015 an extension of time to process the City of Lyford's Application for a sewer certificate of convenience and necessity was granted to the Commission staff. The Extension gives the Applicant (Lyford) until December 10, 2015 to provide additional information. Applicant Lyford hereby requests an additional 60 days in order to provide the information needed.


An extension is required because Lyford is still in negotiations with the North Alamo Water Supply Corporation who is now under different management from when the original agreement was struck. While it is anticipated that the parties will soon reach an agreement, North Alamo Water Supply Corporation will have to take the proposed agreement before their Board and the City of Lyford staff will have to get the City Commission's approval at a commission meeting. Because of the upcoming holidays and the infrequency of formal meetings which must be properly noticed, additional time is needed.

Applicant believes that an additional 60 days will be sufficient time for the procedural acts to take place and for the information to be submitted to the Commissions' Staff.

Wherefore, Applicant City of Lyford respectfully requests an extension of 60 days from December 10, 2015 in order to present the final additional information to the Commission's Staff.
