**COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION AND REQUEST  
FOR EXTENSION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Supplemental Recommendation and Request for Extension. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

The City of Lyford filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Willacy County. The Public Utility Commission (Commission) received the application on November 20, 2014. On May 25, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 8, requiring the City of Lyford to provide a large scale map and digital data by June 20, 2016. Order No. 8 also required Staff to file a final recommendation by July 18, 2016. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. RECOMMENDATION**

City of Lyford has not provided the revised large scale map and digital data required by Commission Order No. 6. Staff continues to request that the City of Lyford provide a large scale map showing the proposed water service area with enough detail to accurately locate the proposed area, as well as revised digital data for the revised proposed water service area. Staff has been in contact with the City of Lyford in an attempt to assist the City of Lyford with mapping issues. Staff recommends that the application remain deficient until the City of Lyford is able to comply with Order No. 6.

**III. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Staff requests that the City of Lyford be given until August 31, 2016 to provide the map and digital data. Staff also requests until September 27, 2016 to file a final recommendation.

#### **IV. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendations.




