COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Supplemental Recommendation. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND

The City of Lyford filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Willacy County. The Public Utility Commission (Commission) received the application on November 20, 2014. On September 30, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 8, requiring the City of Lyford to provide a large scale map and digital data by October 25, 2016. On November 3, 2016, City of Lyford filed supplemental mapping information. Order No. 8 also required Staff to file a final recommendation by November 18, 2016. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION

Staff has reviewed the large scale maps and digital data filed by City of Lyford, and has determined that the maps and digital data accurately show the location of the proposed water service area and reflect the agreement between City of Lyford and North Alamo Water Supply Corporation (North Alamo WSC).

III. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule for the processing of this docket:

Deadline for City of Lyford and Staff to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law	February 23, 2017

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendations.




