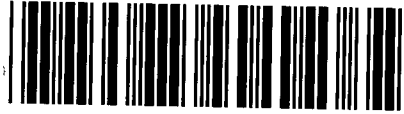

**ORDER NO. 10
REQUIRING FILING**

On February 6, 2017, Commission Staff filed a motion to dismiss the City of Lyford's application for failure to sufficiently amend the application to cure the deficiencies with the mapping documentation. Commission Staff stated that Lyford and North Alamo Water Supply Corporation did not consent to the final proposed maps and that it is unclear which sets of maps and digital data that have been filed are accurate:

On or before March 31, 2017, the City of Lyford shall file a response to Commission Staff's motion to dismiss. Failure to respond to this Order may result in dismissal of the application.
