REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL TIME

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest, and files this Request for Additional Time.

I. BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

Corix Utilities (Texas) Inc. (Applicant) filed 17 related sale, transfer, or merger applications with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE ANN. § 13.301, which were subsequently consolidated under Docket No. 42867(Application).¹ The Commission received the applications between September 15 and September 22, 2014. The Application is now being reviewed pursuant to the TEX. WATER CODE §§ 13.254 and 13.301, the PUC's SUB. R. 24.109 and 24.112.

In Order No. 3, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) consolidated the applications under the above referenced docket number, deemed them administratively complete, and found they provided sufficient notice. On February 26, 2015, Staff recommended approval of the Application. Order No. 6 allowed the parties until April 30, 2015 to file a Joint Proposed Notice of Approval.

II. Request For Additional Time

On April 28, 2015, Corix circulated a Draft Joint Proposed Notice of Approval amongst the parties. Staff is reviewing the draft and communicating with the

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parties to develop a final version. Therefore, Staff requests that the parties be allowed until May 8, 2015 to file a Joint Proposed Notice of Approval. Staff notified the parties of its intention to file this pleading but had not heard back from LCRA by the time of filing. Corix did not object.


III. CONCLUSION
