REQUESTING CLARIFICATION

On February 26, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a recommendation on final disposition regarding the multiple applications consolidated into the instant docket. Attached to the recommendation was the memorandum of Debi Loockerman of the Water Utility Regulation Division.¹ On May 8, 2015, Corix Utilities (Corix), Lower Colorado River Authority (LCRA), and Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a joint proposed notice of approval.

The administrative law judge requests confirmation and or clarification on or before June 22, 2015, that at the time of application filing (April 2013), the only service area not included in LCRA CCN No. 20769 was area in Lampasas County served by the Lometa sewer system.

¹ The third paragraph in the memorandum refers to certificates of convenience and necessity (CCNs) Nos. 12671 and 11019. Since these numbers relate to entities not involved in this proceeding, the ALJ assumes they were cited in error.
