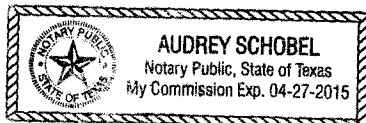

Corix Utilities, Texas, Inc. has filed applications to obtain CCNs with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality to provide water and sewer utility service in Colorado County, Texas.

If a public hearing is requested, the Executive Director will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
