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**ORDER NO. 3  
ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On October 6, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff responded to Order No. 2, providing an update on the status of this application and proposing a procedural schedule. Commission Staff stated that on April 17, 2014, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality issued a letter informing the parties that a public hearing would not be requested on their application, that the parties could complete their proposed transaction, and that a transfer of the CCN would occur following receipt of a copy of the signed contract or bill of sale and documents supporting the disposition of customer deposits. Commission Staff also stated Quadvest, L.P. has notified the Commission that they are in the process of completing the transaction with HMW Utility District.


Consistent with the above representations by Commission Staff, pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(e), the parties have until April 17, 2015 to file with the Commission documents evidencing completion of the proposed transaction. However, to encourage the parties to finalize the proposed transaction as soon as possible, the following procedural schedule is adopted.

Date application was filed.	July 3, 2013
Date of approval to proceed with the transaction.	April 17, 2014 (pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(e), valid for one year)
Deadline(s) for applicants to file a status update on (i) the transaction and (ii) filing of	December 1, 2014, and monthly thereafter until documents evidencing

documents evidencing completion of the transaction.	completion of the transaction have been filed.
Deadline for seller to file verified report of customer deposits in accordance with P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(d).	30 days after closing of transaction
Deadline for Staff to file recommendation on final disposition.	30 days after whichever occurs last, receipt of documents evidencing completion of the transaction or receipt of verified report of customer deposits (if applicable).
If no disputed issues, deadline for parties to file proposed notice of approval with findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs.	20 days after Commission Staff's final recommendation
