**COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 10
PROPOSED ADDITIONAL PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Response to Order No. 10. In support thereof, Staff shows the following:

I. BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

On July 26, 2013, Crystal Clear Water Supply Corporation (Crystal Clear) and City of San Marcos (collectively, the Applicants) filed an application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and to amend a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Comal, Guadalupe, and Hays Counties, held by the City of San Marcos, pursuant to Tex. Water Code Ann. §§ 13.246 and 13.301 and 30 Tex. Admin. Code § 291.109 (TAC). On November 9, 2015, the Commission consolidated Docket No. 42984 into this docket because both dockets involve transfers of certificated service area between Crystal Clear and the City of San Marcos: from Crystal Clear to the City of San Marcos in Docket No. 42983 and from the City of San Marcos to Crystal Clear in Docket No. 42984.

Order No. 9 was issued on November 9, 2015 requiring Commission Staff to confirm that the certificates and map provided in Docket No. 42983 cover the amendments and transfers requested in Docket No. 42983 and 42984, file updated certificate(s) and/or updated map(s), or request additional time, if necessary. Order No. 10, issued November 18, 2015, allowed Staff until December 16, 2015 to file a response.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff has prepared an updated map to address concerns raised in order No. 9. Staff will soon be sending this updated map and consent forms to the parties to confirm their consent. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for parties to return the consent forms to the Commission	January 15, 2016
Deadline for Staff to provide further clarification to the ALJ regarding its final recommendation	January 29, 2016


III. CONCLUSION


