The City of San Marcos's application includes the decertification (transfer) of approximately 4,044 _{acc} acres to Crystal Clear WSC and the amendment of approximately 2,462 acres to add to the City of San Marcos's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity – the transaction includes the purchase of facilities and the acquisition of 206 current customers from Crystal Clear WSC – This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services. Customers being transferred will have their rates adjusted to the rates paid by existing City of San Marcos's customers.

Crystal Clear WSC's application includes the decertification (transfer) of approximately 4,510 acres to the City of San Marcos and the amendment of approximately 1,360 acres to add to the Crystal Clear WSC's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity. The transaction includes the purchase of facilities and the acquisition of 239 current customers from the City of San Marcos. This transaction will have the following effect on the current customers' rates and services: Customers being transferred will have their rates adjusted to the rates paid by existing Crystal Clear WSC's customers.

A request for a public hearing must be in writing. You must state (1) your name, mailing address, and daytime telephone number, (2) the applicant's name, application number or another recognizable reference to this application, (3) the statement, "I/we request a public hearing", (4) a brief description of how you or the persons you represent, would be adversely affected by the granting of the application for a CCN, and (5) your proposed adjustment to the application of CCN which would satisfy your concerns and cause you to withdraw your request for a hearing.

Persons who wish to intervene or comment should write the

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, the Commission will not issue the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil rual in state district court.

If you are a landowner with a tract of land at least 25 acres or more, that is partially or wholly located within the proposed area, you may request to be excluded from the proposed area (or "opt out") by providing written notice to the Commission within (30) days from the date that notice was provided by the applicant. All request to opt out of the requested service area must include a scaled, general location map and a meters and bounds description of the tract of land.

Persons who meet the requirements to opt out, and wish to request this option should file the required documents with the.
