The above referenced application, received on September 13, 2013, has been assigned Application No. 37727-S, but has not been accepted for filing. Please refer to the application number in future correspondence.

On November 14, 2012, the Commission implemented a policy change that requires applicants for CCN related applications to provide a complete list of entities providing the same type of retail utility service (i.e., water and/or sewer) as requested in the application, within a specified area. For applicants requesting a new CCN for the first time, the requirement is to provide a list of entities within a five mile area of the proposed area. For applicants requesting to amend an existing CCN, the requirement is to provide a list of entities within two miles of the proposed area. In addition to this information, the Commission also requires that applicants provide a list of cities whose corporate limits and/or extra-territorial jurisdiction (ETJ) are within the same two and/or five mile area of the proposed CCN area.

The list provided in your applications is deficient. In order for your application(s) to be accepted for filing, please provide a complete list of all retail public utilities,

counties, cities and ETJs within two miles of your proposed CCN area. Please note, this includes districts and groundwater conservation districts.

Please use the TCEQ's iWud Viewer (Viewer) as a guide to begin assembling this list. You can access the Viewer using the following link: http://www.tceq.texas.gov/gis/iwudview.html. Please note, the Viewer only provides information on municipalities with a registered CCN number and some districts.

In addition, Financial Managerial and Technical (FMT) Assistance is available for applicants if needed.

The neighboring utility list must be completed and returned to our office by **November 7, 2012**. If we do not receive the requested information by this date, your application will be returned for failure to prosecute.
