**CONSOLIDATING APPLICATIONS AND
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On October 9, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a motion to consolidate Docket Nos. 42995 and 42996.

Consolidation. Commission Staff recommended that, because the above-styled dockets address the sale, transfer, and cancellation of water Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCNs) and because the CCNs are part of the same proposed transaction, consolidation of these dockets is appropriate. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Docket Nos. 42995 and 42996 are consolidated into Docket No. 42995. All future filings shall be made only in Docket No. 42995 and styled as follows: *Application of Kaufman County Municipal*

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Utility District No. 12 and Kaufman County Municipal Utility District No. 11 for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Kaufman County (37742-S, 37743-S).

Procedural Schedule. Commission Staff recommended a proposed procedural schedule for the remainder of this consolidated proceeding. Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(e), approval of the sale expires on June 6, 2015. This application has been pending since October 2, 2013. In an effort to finalize this case as soon as possible, the following procedural schedule shall apply:

Deadline for seller to file verified report of customer deposits in accordance with P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(d)	30 days after transaction closed
Deadline for Commission Staff to propose a schedule for the remainder of this proceeding	10 days after receipt of documents evidencing completion of the transaction and receipt of verified report of customer deposits (if applicable)
