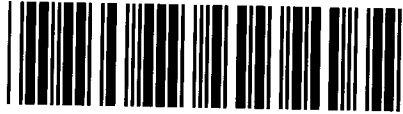

ORDER NO. 2

CONSOLIDATING DOCKETS AND GRANTING EXTENSION

On October 1, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff responded, separately, to Order No. 2 regarding the status of these proceedings.

Consolidation. Commission Staff recommended that, because the above-styled dockets address the sale, transfer, and cancellation of water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12809 in Docket No. 43005 and sewer CCN No. 20814 in Docket No. 43006 and because both CCNs are part of the same proposed transaction, consolidation of these dockets is appropriate. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Docket No. 43005 and 43006 are consolidated into Docket No. 43005. All future filings shall be made only in Docket No. 43005.

Extension. Commission Staff requested additional time in which to review these proceedings prior to establishing a procedural schedule for processing, including the need, if any, for a hearing or regarding final disposition. Commission Staff's request for extension is

granted. Commission Staff shall file, not later than October 10, 2014, a recommendation on the need for a hearing or on final disposition of the consolidated application, if appropriate at this time, or propose a procedural schedule for processing.
