ORDER NO. 9 FINDING APPLICATION CONTINUES TO BE DEFICIENT AND REQUIRING FILINGS

On September 9, 2015, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff filed a recommendation that the application remains insufficient for filing. Specifically, the City of Dorchester's July 20, 2015, filing did not cure the mapping deficiencies. Commission Staff recommended the City of Dorchester be afforded additional time to cure the deficiencies as detailed in Commission Staff's filing and attached memorandum of Mary Lupo and Tracy Harbour of the Water Utility Regulation Division. Commission Staff included instructions for the City of Dorchester to follow in order to improve its next filing. Processing of the application cannot proceed until the requested items are received and reviewed. The City of Dorchester should not send out notice to affected parties until the deficiencies have been cured.

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the City of Dorchester shall file, not later than **October 2**, **2015**, the supplemental information identified by Commission Staff in order to cure the application deficiencies. On or before **November 3**, **2015**, Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if deemed administratively complete.
