ORDER NO. 11
DEEMING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
ADDRESSING NOTICE; AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

I. Application

On May 5, 2014, City of Dorchester filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality an application to amend a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Grayson County. The application was received by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on September 18, 2014.

II. Commission Staff Recommendation on Administrative Completeness

On November 17, 2015, Commission Staff filed recommended that the application, as amended, be deemed sufficient for filing. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the application, as amended, is deemed administratively complete.

III. Commission Staff Recommendation on Notice

Commission Staff recommended that the City of Dorchester provide notice as instructed on Attachment A to Commission Staff's November 17, 2015 filing using the sample draft notices and affidavit forms included as Attachment B to Commission Staff's filing.


Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the City of Dorchester shall provide notice as described in Commission Staff's November 17, 2015 filing consistent with the criteria outlined in the memorandum of Mary Lupo of the Commission's Water Utility Regulation Division, using the forms attached to the Commission Staff memorandum. The City of Dorchester shall file affidavits evidencing proof of notice following the provision of notice.

IV. Proposed Procedural Schedule

On or before **January 6, 2016**, Commission Staff shall propose a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.
