PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest and files this Proposed Procedural Schedule. In support thereof, Staff would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND

On May 5, 2014, the City of Dorchester (Applicant or Dorchester) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application (Application) to amend water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12013 and decertify a portion of CCN 10150 in Grayson County pursuant to Tex. Water Code §§ 13.242 thru 13.250 (TWC) and 16 Tex. Admin. Code §§ 24.101 thru 24.107 (TAC). The Application was received by the Commission on October 1, 2014.

Order No. 11 deemed the Application sufficient, and instructed the Applicant to issue notice and provide proof of notice. To date, proof of notice has not been filed with the Commission. Order No. 12 allowed Staff until February 19, 2015 to file an additional proposed procedural schedule.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff spoke with a representative of the Applicant, who stated they had never received Order No. 11 or 12 due to mailing problems. They further represented that the Applicant intends to continue to prosecute the Application. Therefore, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Staff to file a final recommendation and/or an additional procedural schedule	April 4, 2016


CONCLUSION


