DEFINITIONS

- Staff 2-4 Please provide a copy of the most recent TCEQ Comprehensive Compliance Investigation (CCI).
- **Staff 2-5** Please provide a copy of the City's most recent audited financial statements.
- **Staff 2-6** If the City's 2015 financial statements are not audited provide a copy of the most recent unaudited financial statements.
