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APPLICATION OF THE CITY OF \$ BEFORE THE GRATE OFFICE DORCHESTER TO AMEND A \$ FILING CLERK CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE \$ OF AND NECESSITY IN GRAYSON \$ COUNTY (37917-C) \$ ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS

MOTION OF CITY OF DORCHESTER, TEXAS TO DISMISS INTERVENOR CITY OF HOWE, TEXAS

NOW COMES the City of Dorchester, Texas (Dorchester) and files its Motion to Dismiss Intervenor City of Howe, Texas, and request remand to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) for further proceedings.

1. Background.

On January 14, 2016, the City of Howe (Howe) filed with the Commission its Request for Public Hearing. Howe is the only entity to request a contested case hearing on Dorchester's application to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN). Based on Howe's request for a hearing, on April 25, 2016, the Commission issued an order referring this docket to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing on Dorchester's application before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ).

In SOAH Order No. 1 (May 6, 2016), the ALJ ordered a telephonic Prehearing Conference to occur at 10:00 a.m. on May 20, 2016. However, Howe did not participate in this conference. When the ALJ called Howe's designated representative, City Administrator Joe Shephard, he declined to participate in the call. *See* SOAH Order No. 2 Memorializing Prehearing Conference (May 26, 2016). At that point during the telephonic prehearing conference, Dorchester moved to dismiss Howe and remand the proceeding to the Commission. *Id.* The ALJ requested that

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Dorchester file a written motion to remand by June 1, 2016. *Id.* In support of its Motion to Dismiss Howe, Dorchester would show as follows:

2. Dismissal for failure to appear.

A contested case may be disposed of if a party that is provided sufficient, reasonable notice of the time, date, and place of an administrative hearing fails to appear. *Fox v. Medina*, 848 S.W.2d 866, 871-72 (Tex. App. – Corpus Christi 1993, no writ). Howe was provided notice of the hearing in SOAH Order No. 1, but failed to appear – despite being called by the ALJ before the hearing began.

The Commission's procedural rules allow a party to move to dismiss a proceeding for failure to prosecute or other good cause shown. 16 Tex. Admin. Code § 22.181(a)(1). Further, SOAH's rules for telephonic conferences state that failure to answer the telephone, failure to free the line for the proceeding, or failure to be ready to proceed constitutes a failure to appear, and grounds for default. 1 Tex. Admin. Code § 155.405(f). Howe was contacted by phone at the scheduled time of the hearing, but did not free the line and was not ready to proceed. As such, SOAH rules provide for dismissal of Howe for failure to prosecute and for the ALJ to proceed in Howe's absence on a default basis. 1 Tex. Admin Code § 155.501(a). Howe was the only entity to request a contested case hearing; in Howe's absence, the proceeding should return to the Commission. The ALJ should, therefore, announce Howe's default for failure to appear, recess the hearing, issue an order dismissing the case from the SOAH docket, and return the file to the Commission for further proceedings. *Id.* at § 155.501(d).

3. Howe has not demonstrated that it is an affected person.

Howe requested a public hearing in order "to present evidence on its CCN" because it alleges that Dorchester has presented a "visual depiction of an overlap between Howe's CCN and the Dorchester's CCN." The "List of Issues" filed by Howe on May 4, 2016 lists only three issues, each related to Howe's own CCN area and the purported overlap with Dorchester's CCN. Howe's only two filings in this proceeding – its Request for a Public Hearing and its subsequent List of Issues – assert no other interest in this proceeding other than clarifying Howe's own CCN boundary.

A person may only intervene in a Commission proceeding if that person has a right to participate, which is expressly conferred by statute, commission rule, or order, or other law, or if he or she has a justiciable interest which may be adversely affected by the outcome of the proceeding. 16 Tex. ADMIN. CODE § 22.103(b). A justiciable interest is akin to standing to maintain a suit, which consists of some interest peculiar to a person individually and not as a member of the general public.²

Howe has not asserted that it is an affected person and, therefore, entitled to intervention in this proceeding. It has not described the ways in which it would be affected if Dorchester's application was granted. It has not identified a statute, rule, order, or other law granting it a right to participate, or a justiciable interest unique to Howe. Rather, Howe has asserted general concerns that its CCN and Dorchester's CCN may overlap. As discussed further below, they do not. Moreover, the purpose of this proceeding is not to determine the boundary of Howe's CCN area. Other legal recourse may be available to Howe for that purpose. Rather, the purpose of this

proceeding is to determine whether Dorchester has met all legal requirements for its application to amend its CCN and decertify a portion of another CCN. *See* Commission Staff's List of Issues (May 4, 2016). Howe has not stated any personal interest in Dorchester's application. For this additional reason, Howe should be dismissed from this proceeding.

4. No overlap in CCNs.

Howe has asserted that Dorchester has "presented a visual depiction of an overlap between the City of Howe's CCN and the City of Dorchester's CCN." However, Dorchester has already addressed this claim to the Commission's satisfaction. Revised digital mapping was submitted to the Commission on May 12, July 20, and October 2, 2015. In response, Commission Staff determined that Dorchester's application was sufficient for filing, and the Commission issued Order No. 11, deeming Dorchester's application administratively complete. The Commission has, therefore, already determined that the area at issue in Dorchester's application does not overlap with Howe's CCN. Thus, the only issue raised by Howe – even if it were a relevant area of inquiry in this proceeding – is already moot. A case becomes moot and, therefore, appropriate for dismissal if a party seeks to obtain a judgment on some controversy, when in reality none exists. *Texas Health Care Info. Council v. Seton Health Plan Inc.*, 94 S.W.3d 841, 846-47 (Tex. App. – Austin 2002, pet. denied). Howe should therefore be dismissed from this proceeding.

5. If a MUD is located within the ETJ of two cities, it can choose from whom it receives service.

Finally, Howe vaguely alleges that Dorchester's application "involves matters within the City of Howe's Extra Territorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) and, thus, may relate to other matters and authority." Cottonwood Municipal Utility District No. 2 and Cottonwood Municipal Utility District No. 2B (the Districts) reside within the ETJs of both Howe and Dorchester.

A municipal utility district that is located within the ETJs of more than one municipality may, by resolution, select the municipality that may exercise authority within the district as a whole. Tex. Water Code § 54.0163. This statute requires the municipal utility district to file a certified copy of its board's resolution selecting the municipality with each municipality, as well as the real property records of the county in which it resides. The Districts have selected Dorchester to exercise authority over the district. *See* Exhibit A. The boards of the Districts adopted resolutions selecting Dorchester, notified Howe of their selection, and filed the appropriate documents in the real property records of Grayson County, Texas. *Id.* Howe, therefore, has no justiciable interest in the Districts' location within their ETJ, as the Districts have selected Dorchester's jurisdiction pursuant to Texas Water Code § 54.0163.

6. Conclusion.

For the reasons stated above, the Dorchester prays that Howe be dismissed from this proceeding, for the ALJs to recess the hearing and issue an order dismissing the case from the SOAH docket, and return the file to the Commission for further proceedings.


