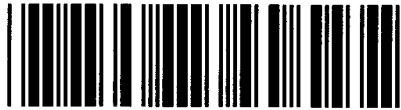

**COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 2 AND REQUEST FOR
ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE STATUS UPDATE**

COMES NOW the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), representing the public interest and files this Commission Staff's Response to Order No. 2 and Request for Additional Time to File Status Update, and would show the following:

I. BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

On May 5, 2014, the City of Dorchester (Applicant or Dorchester) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application to amend water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12013 in Grayson County pursuant to TEX. WATER CODE ANN. §§ 13.242 thru 13.250 and 30 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §§ 291.101 thru 291.107.¹ The application was received by the Commission on October 1, 2014. In Order No. 2, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) required comments on the status of this application by December 12, 2014. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. STATUS UPDATE

Staff is working diligently to process this application; however, Staff needs more time to process the mapping related to this application and requests additional time to file a status update. Staff proposes that its next status update be filed February 19, 2015 as indicated by the Proposed Procedural Schedule below.

IV. CONCLUSION


Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above recommendations.
