- Staff 4-1 Based on a review of mapping data provided by Dorechester, Staff noted an overlap with the borders of Kings Crossing MUD. Kings Crossing MUD has the ability to provide retail water service within their district boundaries; therefore, Staff requests written consent from Kings Crossing MUD allowing the City of Dorchester to provide retail water service within the district's boundary.
- Staff 4-2 This application is requesting additional area that would expand Dorechester's CCN which could result in additional customers in the future and additional needed capacity. Staff requests any documentation submitted to TCEQ for any future additions to plant to accommodate future customers and increased capacity.
