STATUS REPORT AND AGREED MOTION TO ABATE THE HEARING

NOW COMES the City of Dorchester, Texas (Dorchester), and files this Status Report and Agreed Motion to Abate the Hearing until January 6, 2017.

On November 18, 2016, Dorchester filed additional information with the Public Utility Commission's (PUC) staff. Dorchester continues to work with the PUC Staff to address questions and understand the information Dorchester has provided to PUC. Dorchester requests abatement of this hearing until January 6, 2017 to allow Dorchester and the PUC staff to work together on outstanding questions and discuss resolution of any disputes regarding Dorchester's proposed certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) amendment application. Dorchester requests that the Administrative Law Judge order that the parties provide the Judge with a status report on January 6, 2017. Dorchester has emailed the representatives for Walton Texas, LP, and the City of Howe. The City of Howe does not oppose the abatement, but Dorchester has not yet heard back from Walton Texas, LP. The attorney for the PUC staff does not object to this motion.
