## CITY OF DORCHESTER'S SECOND SET OF RESPONSES TO FOURTH REQUEST FOR INFORMATION FROM THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF TEXAS

COMES NOW, the City of Dorchester (City), by and through its undersigned attorney, and files this its Second Set of Responses to the Public Utility Commission (PUC) Staff's Fourth Request for Information. This Response may be treated by all parties as if it was filed under oath. The amended response is addressed below:

Staff 4-1. Based on a review of mapping data provided by Dorchester, Staff noted an overlap with the borders of Kings Crossing MUD. Kings Crossing MUD has the ability to provide retail water service within their district boundaries; therefore, Staff requests written consent from Kings Crossing MUD allowing the City of Dorchester to provide retail water service within the District's boundary.

## **ANSWER:**

As a result of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's review and amendment to the shapefile for the Kings Crossing MUD, the overlap between the City's proposed CCN has been reduced to 13.9 feet. Because there continues to be a small overlap, the City, by this filing, is amending its proposed CCN request to eliminate the overlap. Please find attached to this Response the revised maps and electronic mapping data that eliminate the overlap between the City's proposed CCN amendment and Kings Crossing MUD. Please accept this revised information as a revision to the CCN the City is requesting as part of its application.




