SOAH ORDER NO. 22 GRANTING AGREED MOTION TO WITHDRAW APPLICATION & DISMISSING CASE

On May 5, 2014, the City of Dorchester (City) filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) an application (Application) to amend water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12013 and decertify a portion of CCN No. 10150 in Grayson County pursuant to Texas Water Code §§ 13.242 and 13.250 (TWC) and 16 Texas Administrative Code §§ 24.101 through 24.107 (TAC). On October 1, 2014, the Application was transferred to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission or PUC).

On November 13, 2017, the City filed its Request to Withdraw Application and Motion for Dismissal without Prejudice (Motion). The Motion indicates that the City seeks to withdraw its application because the plans and specifications requested by the PUC are currently not available at this time. The Motion also indicates that PUC Staff, Walton Texas, L.P., and the City of Howe, do not object to the Motion.

The Administrative Law Judge finds that the Motion has merit and is hereby **GRANTED**. It is further **ORDERED** that this case is hereby **DISMISSED** from SOAH's docket.
