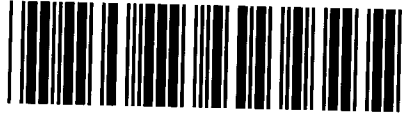



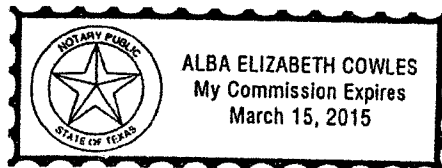

**ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION AND NOTICE COMPLETE;
AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On December 10, 2014, Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Staff responded to Order No. 3 regarding the above-styled and numbered proceeding.

Commission Staff determined, following a review of Inline Development LLC's (Inline's) application supplement, that all deficiencies were corrected. Commission Staff recommended that Inline be directed to provide proper notice to its customers and properly calculate all dollar amounts regarding the water and sewer billing comparisons on the Notice of Proposed Rate Change at least 60 days prior to the effective date of the rate increase. Further, Commission Staff recommended that Inline provide proof that notice was provided.

For the reasons presented in Commission Staff's recommendation, Inline's application and proposed notice are found to be complete. Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, Inline shall provide notice to its customers and properly calculate all dollar amounts regarding the water and sewer billing comparisons with an effective date at least 60 days prior to the effective date of the rate increase pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.22. Not later than 30 days following provision of notice, Inline shall file an affidavit providing proof that notice was provided.

Within 10 days of receipt of Inline's affidavit of proof of notice, Commission Staff shall propose a schedule for continued processing of the application.
