**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION AND FOR GOOD  
CAUSE EXCEPTION**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), representing the public interest, and files this Response to Order No. 5, and would show the following:

**I. BACKGROUND**

On August 28, 2014, Inline Development LLC (Inline) filed an Application for Water and Sewer Rate/Tariff Change (Application) for water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12946 and sewer CCN No. 20879 in Harris County. On April 10, 2015, Order No. 6 was issued, finding Inline's proof of notice sufficient, and establishing May 20, 2015 as the deadline for Staff to either request a hearing or to issue a final recommendation.

**II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Pursuant to 16 Tex. Admin. Code (TAC) 22.4(b) (TAC), Staff may request the time for filing any documents be extended for good cause. In addition, 16 TAC 24.28(3) requires that Staff request a hearing within 120 days of the effective date of the rate. Commission Staff has been reviewing Inline's application, but requires additional time to complete its evaluation. Staff requests good cause to extend the procedural schedule as set out below. Staff is authorized to represent that Inline does not object to the extension.

### III. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:


Event	Deadline
If no protest from an affected municipality or sufficient ratepayer protests received, deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing <b>OR</b> Deadline for Commission Staff's recommendation on the compliance of Inline's proposed tariff	May 27, 2015
Deadline for Inline to respond to Commission Staff's recommendation on tariff compliance or request a hearing <b>OR</b> If no disputed issues, deadline for parties to file proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law, and ordering paragraphs	June 10, 2015


