ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION AND NOTICE DEFICIENT  
AND RESTYLING APPLICATION

I. Application

On August 21, 2014, T&W Water Service Company (T&W or Company) filed an application to amend its water certificate of convenience (CCN) No. 12892 in Waller County.

II. Staff Recommendation on Sufficiency of Application and Notice

On September 25, 2014, Commission Staff filed comments on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice. Commission Staff has determined that the application contains material deficiencies and is not administratively complete. In addition, Staff determined that T&W's proposed notice does not meet the requirements of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.106.

III. Restyling Application

Commission Staff noted that this application is also intended to decertify a portion of CCN No. 12391 held by G&W Water Supply Corporation.<sup>1</sup> For this reason, the style of the case is revised to read: *Application of T&W Water Service Company to Amend its Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and to Decertify a Portion of the Certificate of G&W Water Supply Corporation in Waller County.*

#### IV. Proposed Procedural Schedule

Commission Staff proposes that T&W be given thirty (30) days to address the deficiencies noted by Commission Staff. Commission Staff will file additional comments regarding completeness of the amended application, along with a proposed procedural schedule once the application is administratively complete.

#### V. Finding Application Deficient and Opportunity to Cure

Consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, T&W's application and notice is found administratively incomplete. On or before **October 27, 2014**, T&W shall file an amended application to cure the deficiencies noted by Staff. Processing of the application cannot proceed and notice cannot be published or mailed until the requested items are received and reviewed.

Commission Staff shall file a supplemental recommendation regarding sufficiency of the amended application and notice along with a proposed procedural schedule within ten working days of receipt of the amended application.
