# COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

Commission Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) files its Recommendation. In support of its Recommendation, Staff states the following:

#### I. Background

On September 9, 2014, J&S Water Company, LLC (J&S Water) filed an application requesting approval of the sale and transfer of a water system and sewer system and corresponding certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN Nos. 12085 and 20658) for a certificated area in Harris County, Texas. J&S Water is the seller, and Utilities Investment Company, Inc. (Utilities Investment) is the purchaser. The proposed effective date is February 1, 2015.

On September 23, 2014, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 3, which found J&S Water's application incomplete and J&S Water's proposed notice insufficient. J&S Water was given an opportunity to cure the deficiencies identified in Order No. 3.

In response to Order No. 3, J&S Water, Utilities Investment, or their authorized representative filed additional documents with the Commission.

On June 16, 2015, the Administrative Law Judge entered Order No. 4. Order No. 4 requires Staff to file a recommendation regarding administrative completeness of J&S Water's application and sufficiency of J&S Water's revised proposed notice by June 30, 2015. Staff's Recommendation is timely filed.

### II. Applicable Legal Standards

# A. Commission Approval of the Sale and Transfer of a Water or Sewer System

The Texas Water Code details the requirements for the sale of a water or sewer system.

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The relevant portions of the Texas Water Code state:

- (a) A utility or a water supply or sewer service corporation, on or before the 120th day before the effective date of a sale, acquisition, lease, or rental of a water or sewer system that is required by law to possess a certificate of public convenience and necessity or the effective date of a merger or consolidation with such a utility or water supply or sewer service corporation, shall:
  - (1) file a written application with the utility commission; and
  - (2) unless public notice is waived by the utility commission for good cause shown, give public notice of the action.
- (b) The utility commission may require that the person purchasing or acquiring the water or sewer system demonstrate adequate financial, managerial, and technical capability for providing continuous and adequate service to the requested area and any areas currently certificated to the person.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission's substantive rules detail similar requirements for the sale of a water or sewer system.<sup>2</sup> The purchaser of a water or sewer system "must demonstrate adequate financial, managerial, and technical capability for providing continuous and adequate service to the requested area and any areas currently certificated to the person." The Commission has 120 days to either administratively approve a proposed sale or require a hearing.<sup>4</sup>

With regards to the sale and transfer of a certificate of convenience and necessity, the Texas Water Code states that a certificate of convenience and necessity may not be sold "unless the utility commission has determined that the purchaser . . . is capable of rendering adequate and continuous service to every consumer within the certificated area, after considering the factors under Section 13.246(c) [of the Texas Water Code]." The factors to be considered by the Commission are:

(1) the adequacy of service currently provided to the requested area;

- (2) the need for additional service in the requested area, including whether any landowners, prospective landowners, tenants, or residents have requested service;
- (3) the effect of the granting of a certificate or of an amendment on the recipient of the certificate or amendment, on the landowners in the area, and on any retail public utility of the same kind already serving the proximate area;
- (4) the ability of the applicant to provide adequate service, including meeting the standards of the commission, taking into consideration the current and projected density and land use of the area;
  - (5) the feasibility of obtaining service from an adjacent retail public utility;
- (6) the financial ability of the applicant to pay for the facilities necessary to provide continuous and adequate service and the financial stability of the applicant, including, if applicable, the adequacy of the applicant's debt-equity ratio;
  - (7) environmental integrity;
- (8) the probable improvement of service or lowering of cost to consumers in that area resulting from the granting of the certificate or amendment; and
  - (9) the effect on the land to be included in the certificated area.<sup>6</sup>

Approval of the sale and transfer of a certificate of convenience and necessity expires one year after the date of approval.<sup>7</sup>

### B. Notice of a Sale Transaction

An applicant requesting approval of the sale and transfer of assets and accompanying certificates of convenience and necessity must send notice "on the form required by the commission..." In previous sale and transfer applications, Staff has required that an applicant send notice to: (1) current customers; (2) neighboring systems; (3) affected landowners; and (4) neighboring municipalities. With respect to the transfer of a certificate of convenience and necessity, an applicant must provide notice to "cities and neighboring retail public utilities providing the same utility service whose corporate limits or certificated service area boundaries

are within two miles of the requested service area boundaries, and any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service area boundaries." Additionally, the Commission may require the publication of notice of the transfer of a certificate of convenience and necessity. <sup>10</sup>

### C. Administrative Completeness

An application requesting approval of a sale and transfer transaction is not considered filed with the Commission until "a determination of administrative completeness is made." "If the commission determines that material deficiencies exist . . . [the] application may be rejected and the effective date suspended until the deficiencies are corrected."

### III. Staff's Recommendation

Staff has reviewed the additional documents and revised proposed notice submitted by J&S Water or Utilities Investment. Staff recommends the following:

- 1. Staff recommends that J&S Water's application be deemed administratively complete.
- 2. Staff recommends that the following entities receive notice of J&S Water's application:

Utilities Investment Company, Inc. (Applicant) has filed an application to acquire a portion of water and sewer facilities from CCN Nos. 12085 and 20658, held by J&S Water Company, LLC in Harris County, Purchaser currently has both a water and sewer CCN but would like to acquire a new water and sewer CCN, pursuant to the criteria in Texas Water Code 13.301 and Title 16 Texas Administrative Code, Sections 24.109 and 24.112.

The proposed area will include Aldine Village Subdivision (PWS #1010931 &WQ 12382-001), Azalea Estates Mobile Home Community (PWS #1011253), Cottonwood Park Water System (PWS #1010283) and Cypress Hill Subdivision (PWS #1011792)

Based on review of the information in the application, I recommend that the application be deemed sufficient for filing. The supplemental information submitted by the Applicant to the Commission cured the deficiencies previously noted.

In its response to Order No. 3, on October 23, 2014, the purchaser submitted its Financial Statements.

In its response to Order No. 3, on October 23, 2014, the applicant submitted a copy of J&S Water Company, LLC's proposed tariff.

### I further recommend the following:

- 1. Applicant be ordered to provide the correct notice of the application to the following:
  - a. any districts, groundwater conservation districts, counties, utilities, cities, cities with an extraterritorial jurisdiction within two (2) miles of the proposed service areas;
  - b. any city with an extraterritorial jurisdiction which overlaps the proposed service areas:
  - c. any customers transferred, or other affected parties in the requested area; and

within thirty (30) days from the date of this publication or notice. A public hearing will be held only if a legally sufficient hearing request is received or if the Commission on its own motion requests a hearing. Only those individuals who submit a written hearing request or a written request to be notified if a hearing is set will receive notice if a hearing is scheduled.

If a public hearing is requested, Commission will not transfer the CCN and will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, the SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. If an evidentiary hearing is held, it will be a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
