The proposed rates will apply to service received after the effective date provided below, unless modified or suspended by the Commission. If the Commission receives a sufficient number of protests, separately or in a combined protest letter, from at least ¹⁵⁶ [number of] ratepayers (10 percent of the utility's customers over whose rates the Commission has original jurisdiction) or from any affected municipality before the 91st day after the proposed effective date, the matter will be set for hearing. **See Protest Form on the next page for instructions on how to protest.**

EFFECTIVE DATE OF PROPOSED INCREASE: 12/7/2015

(Proposed rates requested by the utility are not final. The Commission may modify the rates and order a refund or credit against future bills all sums collected during the pendency of the rate proceeding in excess of the rate finally ordered plus interest.)

Reason(s) for proposed Rate Change:

Allow the utility to generate enough revenue to cover expenses that are reasonable and necessary to provide service to the ratepayers and allow the utility a reasonable opportunity to earn a reasonable return on its invested capital used and useful in rendering service. In addition a monthly surcharge is requested to make necessary facility improvements to bring these water systems into compliance with TCEQ minimum standards.
