CITY OF ROYSE CITY REVISIONS TO APPLICATION

The City of Royse City, Texas ("City"), files the following-described revisions to its Application to Amend Sewer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") No. 20813 in Collin, Hunt, and Rockwall Counties ("CCN Application"). These revisions are being filed to remove properties owned by individuals who have protested the CCN Application, and also in accordance with Order No. 2 previously issued in this Docket on November 13, 2014. In support hereof, the City would show as follows:

On June 18, 2014, the City filed its CCN Application with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality. Subsequent to the transfer of the regulation of water and sewer CCNs to the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("Commission"), effective September 1, 2014, the City published notice, provided the appropriate notices to surrounding utilities and governmental authorities, and notified property owners within the proposed CCN area. Proof of such notification was provided to Commission Staff on November 21, 2014, and filed with the Commission on December 2, 2014.

Four property owners within the proposed sewer CCN area filed protests with the Commission. Although only one of these protests qualified for removal of the subject property from the CCN Application under the provisions of Texas Water Code § 13.246(h) (*i.e.*, the two tracts owned by Mr. Steve Woody), the City has nevertheless determined to revise the CCN

Application to remove the properties identified in all four protests. These properties and their owners are as follows:

- 1. Mr. Steve Woody:
 A0205 H.T. Chinowith Survey, Tract 63, 35.873 acres in Hunt County.
 A0205 H.T. Chinowith Survey, Tract 62, 41.266 acres in Hunt County.
- Mr. Melvin Joslin:
 A0851 Prewitt Joseph Survey, Tract 24, 2.5 acres in Hunt County.
- 3. Mr. Gerald Gray:
 A946 Shelby County School Land Survey, Tract 23-2,
 1.5 acres in Hunt County.
- Michael and Theresa Gray:
 A0946 Shelby County School Land Survey, Tract 23, 31.273 acres in Hunt County.

The City has provided notice to these four individuals of the revision of the CCN Application to remove their properties. Notification to the individuals included an illustrative map identifying the location of their properties, as well as a copy of the Revised Attachment E to the CCN Application (described below). Copies of such notifications are attached hereto as Attachments 1, 2, 3, and 4.

In order to effectuate the revisions to the CCN Application described herein, Revised Attachments E and G to the CCN Application are being filed herewith, and are attached hereto as Attachments 5 and 6, respectively. The City is also providing the required digital mapping data to conform to the revisions to the CCN Application set forth herein. A disk containing the revised mapping data is attached to this pleading as Attachment 7.

With the removal of these properties from the CCN Application, the CCN Application is not adverse to any party, and no hearing is necessary. The City respectfully requests the Commission take note of these revisions to the City's CCN Application and approve the revised CCN Application under the informal disposition provisions of P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.35.


