We received in our office yesterday, October 13, 2010, your letter dated September 29, 2010, and it was provided to me this evening.

Mt Peak does not consent to the map as included, at this time. The areas involved in the Application appear to be accurate, but the balance of the map, showing the portion of the CCN that is dual certificated does not appear to be accurate when compared with the District's records. The General Manager of the District is coming to the TCEQ offices next week to examine the records and determine the reason for the discrepancy.

Consequently, would you please hold this matter for another week and allow us to investigate these circumstances?

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
