



City of Midlothian Tract ~ 119 Acres

Beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 67 and U.S. Highway 287 for the point of beginning;

Thence in a southeasterly direction along the southern right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 287 approximately 4,300 feet to a point, said point being at the intersection of U.S. Highway 287 and Walter Stephenson Road;

Thence in a southernly direction along the western right-of-way line of Walter Stephenson Road approximately 500 feet to a point;

Thence in a westernly direction approximately 2,200 feet to a point;

Thence in a northernly direction approximately 4,200 feet to the point of beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 67 and U.S Highway 287 and containing approximately 119 acres of land more or less.

Mt. Peak SUD Tract ~ 43 Acres

Beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 67 and U.S. Highway 287 for the point of beginning;

Thence in a northwesternly direction along the northern right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 287 approximately 2,800 feet to a point, said point being at the intersection of U.S. Highway 287 and Business 287 (W. Main Street);

Thence in an easternly direction along the southern right-of-way line of Business 287 (W. Main Street) approximately 1,700 feet to a point, said point being at the intersection of Business 287 (W. Main Street) and U.S. Highway 67;

Thence in a southernly direction along the western right-of-way line of U.S. Highway 67 approximately 2,200 feet to the point of beginning at the intersection of U.S. Highway 67 and U.S. Highway 287 and containing approximately 43 acres of land more or less.
