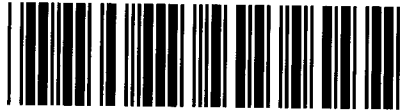

ORDER NO. 6
APPROVING SALE/TRANSFER TO PROCEED

This Order addresses the application of Brazos Valley Septic & Water, Inc. (Brazos Valley) and Nerro Supply, LLC (Nerro) to sell/transfer all water assets held under Brazos Valley's Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12552 to Nerro's CCN No. 13094 (in Brazos, Burleson, and Robertson Counties).

On November 18, 2014, the Public Utility Commission of Texas Staff filed its determination that the application is sufficient and complete, that Nerro has the capability of providing continuous and adequate service to the proposed area and the transaction serves the public interest and that the application should be approved. However, until the requirements of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(e) have been satisfied, Commission approval of the sale/transfer of Brazos Valley's CCN to Nerro's CCN is voidable and amending the parties' CCNs is premature. Brazos Valley's and Nerro's CCN's will be amended once the transfer is complete. Therefore, consistent with Commission Staff's recommendation, the sale/transfer as contemplated in the application may proceed and be consummated, but until the requirements of P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(e) have been satisfied, the Commission's approval can be voided.

Pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 24.112(e), Brazos Valley and Nerro have 365 days from the date of this Order to submit proof in the form of closing documents to the Commission that the sale/transfer has been consummated. If closing documents are not submitted within this period, or an extension granted, approval of this transaction is void.

Beginning January 15, 2015, 2014, Brazos Valley and Nerro shall file monthly updates regarding the status of the sale/transfer.

Within 10 working days of Brazos Valley and Nerro submitting proof that the sale/transfer has been consummated, Commission Staff shall file its recommendation regarding the sufficiency of these documents and propose a schedule for the continued processing of this docket.
