**ORDER NO. 3
GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On October 10, 2014, Order No. 2 established November 3, 2014 as the deadline for Commission Staff to file an update on the status of the consolidated applications of Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 22 (MUD No. 22) requesting new water and sewer Certificates of Convenience and Necessity (CCN), respectively, in Brazoria and Fort Bend Counties and for dual certification with the City of Pearland and Brazoria County Municipal Utility District No. 21. These applications were accepted for filing by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality on August 18, 2014; provided however, MUD No. 22 was required to provide revised public notice and revised mailed notice to certain land owners.


MUD No. 22's applications were transferred to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) on September 1, 2014. On November 3, 2014, Commission Staff responded to Order No. 2 and stated that as of November 3, 2014, the required revised notices and affidavits do not appear to have been filed with the Commission. However, Commission Staff stated that MUD No. 22 has indicated that it sent its revised notice and affidavits to the TCEQ in September, but will refile them with the Commission. These documents may have been inadvertently omitted in the database transfers from the TCEQ to the Commission. Therefore, Commission Staff requests a good cause extension of the deadline for its recommendation on final disposition of this docket or the need for a hearing to November 17, 2014.
