**ORDER NO. 2
REQUIRING ADDITIONAL RESPONSES**

On October 14, 2013, Ede and Randy Bullock (Bullocks) filed a request with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) to investigate RCH Water Supply Corporation (RCH) pursuant to Tex. Water Code § 13.004 (TWC). On March 20, 2015, the Bullocks filed additional details regarding their request to investigate RCH.

On September 24, 2015, RCH responded to Order No. 1, arguing that the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) (1) has limited jurisdiction over a water supply or sewer service corporation and none of Bullock's petition deal with the requirements for classification of RCH as a non-profit water supply or sewer service corporation in Tex. Water Code § 13.002(11) and (24) (TWC); and (2) no jurisdiction with respect to RCH's conducting of its annual or special meetings.


On September 29, 2015, Commission Staff responded to Order No. 1, recommending that RCH be ordered to provide additional information. Specifically, Commission Staff recommends that RCH be ordered to provide (1) a copy of its current tariff and service regulations; and (2)(a) documentation showing that it is registered as a non-profit with the Texas Secretary of State's Office; (b) documentation that it has been registered as a non-profit for the past two years; and (c) documentation that its status as a non-profit is up-to-date and in good standing with the Texas Secretary of State's Office.

Consistent with Commission Staff's preceding recommendation, RCH shall file, not later than **October 15, 2015**, the additional information described above.

On or before **October 22, 2015**, Commission shall file respond regarding the adequacy of RCH's additional information and provide a proposed schedule for further processing of this proceeding, if appropriate.
