On June 23, 2014, the Executive Director of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality pursuant to Chapters 5 and 13 of the Texas Water Code considered the application of Dillon Water Resources, LP, to acquire facilities, and to transfer Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12844 held by Berry Oaks Water Company in Comal County, Texas.

Two protests were received that did not meet the criteria for scheduling a hearing under Texas Water Code, Section 13.301 and Title 30, Texas Administrative Code, Section 291.109(e). Therefore, the application was not referred for a public hearing;

Notice of the application was given to all affected and interested parties:

The criteria set forth in Texas Water Code Sections 13.246(c) and 13.301 have been considered; and

The certificate transfer requested in this application is necessary for the service, accommodation, convenience, and safety of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY that the application is granted and Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12844 be transferred in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth herein and in the certificate.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dillon Water Resources, LP, shall serve every customer and applicant for service within the area certified under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity No. 12844 and that such service shall be continuous and adequate.


