Complaint of Carol D. Gillespie Against Avalon Water Supply and Sewer Services Corporation

The undersigned Administrative Law Judges (ALJs) have read the exceptions and replies to the Proposal for Decision (PFD) in this case. Carol D. Gillespie (Complainant) disagrees with the ALJs' analysis and recommends numerous changes to the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Ordering Provisions. Staff and Avalon Water Supply and Sewer Services Corporation (Avalon) recommend adoption of the PFD and oppose Complainant's proposed changes. Avalon recommends an additional ordering provision that dismisses the case *with prejudice*. The ALJs support Avalon's additional ordering provision but do not recommend any other changes to the PFD.
