APPLICANT'S THIRD RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 4

On January 7, 2014, Tri-County Special Utilities District, *Tri-County*, filed an application to amend a *Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity* in Falls, Limestone, McLennan and Robertson Counties.

By prior orders, Applicant was given until January 20, 2015, to cure deficiencies. Due to miscommunication, Applicant believed that substantial progress had been made with the requests. On February 27, 2015, Applicant's representatives met in person with Commission staff in Austin to discuss the deficiencies and solutions.

In March of 2015, Applicant filed hard-copy maps with enough detail to locate the proposed water service. Applicant continues to try to contact the City of Marlin's attorney to resolve the issue of *Exhibit A* that is missing from the agreement. Attempts were unsuccessful until April 13, 2015, because the City of Marlin's attorney changed law firms. The Public Utilities Commission staff and Applicant continue to work together to cure deficiencies and ambiguities. The attorney for the PUC has no objection to extending the deadline to May 15, 2015.

Applicant requests an extension of time to supplement the application and will provide all required information by May 15, 2015, or provide the Commission with a detailed report on Applicant's progress in meeting the requirements.
